Dear Resident:

The Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works is pleased to announce that Saunders Way has been selected for rehabilitation. This project will consist of roadway pavement reconstruction, replacement of concrete curb and gutter, replacement of existing concrete driveway aprons where applicable, and replacement of existing concrete sidewalk, including installation of new ADA ramps. The limits of construction on Saunders Way are from Farrington Road to the cul-de-sac. Work is scheduled to begin on or about May 11, 2018. (weather permitting). NOTE: We are trying to avoid removing the trees that have large roots near or around the existing concrete curb/gutter. However, there are two trees marked with a white X for removal.

To ensure that this project proceeds in a timely and safe manner, it is important that **all** vehicles be removed from the work areas. While this may be an inconvenience to residents while construction is in progress, cooperation between the contractor and residents will be the key to success. The Contractor will post **No Parking** signs along the edge of the road to indicate the work zone. These signs will announce the anticipated dates the contractor plans to work in this area. Vehicles **cannot** be parked in the posted areas between the posted dates or they **will be towed at the owner's expense**.

Please arrange to have any vehicles that you will need to use on a daily basis, removed from your driveway prior to the removal of the existing concrete curb and driveway apron. When freshly poured concrete has been placed in your driveway area, access to your driveway will remain unavailable for 72 hours while the concrete cures.

Work activity will take place between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. During construction, you may also encounter a rougher road surface. Please use caution when driving in these areas. To provide through traffic during active construction, work will be performed along one side of the road at a time. Although there may be temporary closures associated with the road reconstruction, this road will remain open for traffic during construction. Please pay particular attention to equipment, signs, and flag persons when driving through the work zone.

The county has retained Century Engineering to manage the construction aspects of the project. Please contact the Pavement Management office at (410) 222-4349 if you have any questions or concerns about construction activities.
